Anacamptis pyramidalis | Pyramidal orchid

Synonyms:

Conservation status: CITES-listed species

Anacamptis pyramidalis, also known as the pyramidal orchid is a perennial herbaceous plant belonging to the genus Anacamptis of the family Orchidaceae. Stems grow generally between 10-25 cm, but can grow to a maximum of 60 centimetres. The basal leaves are linear-lanceolate with parallel venation, up to 25cm long, the cauline leaves are shorter and are barely visible on the stem. The arrangement of hermaphroditic flowers in a compact pyramidal shape is a very distinctive feature, which gives this orchid its common name. This orchid can generally be found on meadows or dry and well exposed slopes at an altitude ranging from 0 to 2000 m above sea level, it can be found on a diversity of soils, including but not limited to loamy or clay, it can also grow in very alkaline soil.

Anacamptis papilionacea | Butterfly orchid

Synonyms: Orchis papilionaceae, Anacamptis papilionacea (L.) R.M.Bateman, Pridgeon & M.W.Cha

Conservation status: CITES-listed species

Perennial herb, 15-35 cm high, with oval tubers. The leaves are 3-9, linear-lanceolate, up to 10 cm long, most located in a basal rosette, standing straight up or spread out. The inflorescence is oval to cylindrical, consisting of 3-10 (15) flowers, accompanied by webbed bracts. The petals are collected in a helmet, pink, with clear lines along its length. The labellum is pointed downward, round, up to 15 (17) mm long, notched at the edges, usually with radially spaced lines, sometimes without pattern. The spur is 8-14 mm long, conical, initially horizontal, later bending downward. This orchid blooms from April to May. Besides the seeds, the species is known for vegetative/clonal propagation.

Submitting information

Required fields:

Species name and date are automatically filled in by the software;
Latitude and Longitude are automatically filled in by the software,
if the GPS device is plugged into the tablet;

The closest place, the Observer and the Count of specimens are filled in
mandatory by the user;

Threats and other remarks is an optional field, but it is very important for
the results of the monitoring. Through it, potential threats are submitted
to other important data that are then spreading
to all other users of the software but are not visible to
users with a simple access level on web platform.
